RESULTS OF THE BALLOT

The online consultation conducted from January 25th to February 25th turned out to be very successful again: 84 out of a total of 97 delegates responded (86.60%), representing 426 of a total of 462 votes (92.21 %). I'm glad to inform you that all candidates were accepted with a large majority and we'd like to thank you for your cooperation.

FLASOMA 2017


During the general assembly in Buenos Aires on 8th February, four new societies were admitted to FLASOMA that has now 59 societies with a total of 1.452 members.
